Celebration is essential for our well-being and the health of our communities; it uplifts our spirits and strengthens our resilience and brings us closer together.

The sharing of our annual vision report helps us to focus on the positive outcomes of the year and celebrate our victories. This report is an expression of gratitude to all the people who have invested into the life of the church during the last year. It is a celebration of joy that comes as a breath of fresh air in direct contrast to the chaos and challenges we see on the news every day. I am reminded of the goodness in our church which helps us to celebrate and appreciate the beauty that God has chosen to surround us with.

We are reminded in the Bible that "the joy of the Lord is your strength," and so as we read this report let us respond in joy and celebration because of all that he has done in the last 12 months.



The divine assignment we hold to as a church is to FLOW | GROW | GO. Flow in the presence of the Holy Spirit, grow the family of God and go on the mission of Jesus Christ.

We celebrate the opportunity we have had to study and understand the word of God together with our regular weekly preaching series covering the 10 Commandments (TEN Series), a Night & Day Prayer series covering Thanksgiving. Worship, Intercession, Confession, Repentance, Revelation, Glory and Fasting; The Transformation Encounters of the RESURRECTION; Creating an Apostolic ATMOSPHERE (Ephesians 4:11) and the Jesus is GREATER than Series on Colossians. We have had incredible guest speakers such as Rachel & Gordon Hickson (Heartcry Ministries), Ian Williams, Angela Gaeta (Life Church Vienna) and Chris Murry (Pennywell Farm).

We celebrate that we were able to re-initiate our Global mission strategy by sending out 2 teams of over 20 people to Africa (Kenya & Rwanda). We hosted a 'Living & Telling' Evangelism Course, we launched our 'Warm Spaces' Initiative, we held a Day & Night Prayer Conference in January, a Guitar-Aid benefit Gig in April with James Kirby, a family event to Pennywell Farm, the young adults went off to the Big Church Day Out Festival whilst the children and young people went off to Spree (a camping and activity weekend).

We celebrated the lives of Peter Corney & Martyn Cayley who both served Riverside Church faithfully as they were promoted to Glory, where they now are celebrating in eternity.

We celebrated the joyous weddings as Chris & Lyn (Riverside Exmouth), Matt & Amber, Mason & Amanda, Beth & Levi and PJ and Kay got married.

We celebrate our Leadership development programme with Joshua as he began his Ministerial Training with AOG, Rachel will

complete her ordination process in May 2024 and Levi is due to start his training next Summer. We also would like to celebrate Dave Sumner and Chris Lonsdale as they were formally invited to join the church leadership team.

The other Board members are Adrian Bartlett, Helen Buswell and Aran and Rachel Richardson who, together, form a highly skilled, insightful and trustworthy team.

This year has seen society as a whole breaking free from the shackles of enforced lockdown; it has been terrific to see how the church has grown spiritually, and great to get to know many new friends joining us during the last 12 months. Some have even taken the amazing step of being baptised in the sea at Exmouth. Speaking of which, our church plant, Riverside Exmouth, continues to grow and it has been wonderful that so many people are rolling up their sleeves to make it such a success.

We have been blessed to have two interns join us for the last year, Marlene from Austria and Mateus from Brazil. Both have worked tirelessly within the church and with school and youth ministries. As an organisation, we are moving away from the PAIS model of internship and investing in a structured, Riverside-driven internship programme led by Josh Richardson. This is a hugely exciting development and it's fantastic that Mateus will be staying with us for another year and will be one of the first to experience the new, focused training programme, with others joining him shortly thereafter. Marlene meanwhile has felt called back to her home church and we want to thank and honour her for the amazing work that she has been a part of.

The last year has seen a step-change in prayer, led by Levi and Beth Sarmento Rodrigues. There has been prayer within the building at some point during most days, with pre-service prayer rising up to another level entirely. We have been so blessed to experience greater freedom in the gifts of the Spirit, with so many more people making first time commitments.

The global missions team continues to grow and develop relationships with Missions Partners around the world. It was a particular delight to commission short term mission trips to Kenya and Rwanda, with more being planned for the coming year.

The Board are pleased to have started remunerating Rachel Richardson for 1 day a week, in recognition of her role as Senior Pastor, alongside Aran. The balance of Rachel's time will continue to be voluntary. Meanwhile, Josh's hours have been increased to enable the new internship programme to start well.



Last but certainly not least, I would like to thank and honour all of the leaders, staff and volunteers, every one of whom go above and beyond the call to help make Riverside an inviting place where we welcome the presence of the Holy Spirit, build the family of God and share together in the mission of Jesus Christ! FINANCE REPORT

Jesus says in Mat 6:21 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also". The truth of God's tithes and offerings is that we bring ourselves closer to him when we give. Giving puts our love for God before our worldly wealth and shows that our heart is always with him.

Our accounts run from April22 to March23 so the figures that follow relate to that period. A full set of accounts can be found at Companies House at www.gov.uk.

Thank you to everyone who has given so generously over the last year. Our income for the year from offerings alone was an amazing £151,600. This was topped up by gift aid of £25,300. We are blessed with a wonderful building and have received £31,700 in rental / conference income. Alongside the café and other income, we have achieved a total income of £223,900.

We aim to distribute at least 10% of our income to worthy causes, including missions, and I am pleased to say we exceeded that amount for the first time in many years to just over 11.5% that is nearly £26,000. Another major expense is paying our excellent team members which accounts for just over 40% of our expenditure. Our total expenditure was £215,133.

As a result we transferred £8,787 into our reserves for the year.

We have just completed 5 months into our new financial year (Apr-Aug). I realise that the cost of living is having a severe impact on everyone, and the Church is not excluded from this. If you are not giving via gift aid and pay tax, would you consider this as it's totally free and raises your giving by 25%? There is a leaflet explaining how this works so please speak to me and I can help you out. If you have not had a chance to review your regular giving, could I ask that you prayerfully do so?

It's been a fun few months in kids service on Sunday, and we have seen God move in incredible ways. Our numbers have grown over recent months, which has been a great blessing.

For our Sunday meetings, we have been using the Energize Urban Saints curriculum (www.energize.uk.net) to structure the sessions, and we have been following a template of:



- Meet up all together with one of the children saying a prayer.
- 2. Separating into two groups (younger and older).
- 3. Having Bible study in the form of reading and discussion (older group) and interactive story and questions (younger group).
- 4. Art and craft session.
- 5. Team games.
- 6. Group gathering, snack and video related to the topic[s] studied.

The focus this season has been to unpack a 'year one syllabus' on Energize. For the children, this has opened up the Christian calendar in a more visible way and linked the key Biblical people into the celebrated events.

Following a team lunch at Church we have come up with a few changes to the Sunday Kids Service. Due to numbers, we are dividing the groups into ages 3–8 and 9-11; this will help with dividing up numbers more equally. We've also moved onto more ambitious subject matter on Energize to challenge the older age group.



We are praying for God to build opportunities for deeper study. We are hoping that the children can bring their situations / experiences / problems to Church, read Scripture, identify truth and see the relevance of how this links to their lives. We want the children to see that the Bible is relevant and life fulfilling, rather than something disjointed and confusing.

We look forward to another season of seeing God move.



We love worship and believe that prayer and worship go hand in hand in bringing glory to God. We are hoping to host more worship events over the next year (like the 12 hours of worship), which we will keep you posted about when we have the dates in the diary!

As a church, God has placed a desire in our hearts to create a regular lifestyle of worship in Riverside. Therefore, every Friday from 5 pm to 6:30 pm we have a Prayer and Worship set in the main auditorium. These worship nights will switch between having a full band and having acoustic sets. The whole church will be welcome to come at any point within the set; to bring a Bible or a notebook, to sit in God's presence listening to Him and ministering back to His heart.

FOUR GOFFES













GLOBAL MISSION

After what seems like such a long time waiting, 2023 has at last been the year when we've been able to go abroad on Mission Trips. After several years of planning and refining the mandate and model of Global Mission within Riverside, it has been so amazing to be able to send teams out to Kenya and Rwanda on short term missions.

February's trip to Kenya involved working with Riverside Church Kisumu, which was originally planted by Rose Lillie. Activities involved a mixture of practical help with building a toilet block, to preaching to thousands of people. Incredibly, approximately 1,000 people were saved during the 8 day trip.



June's mission to Rwanda linked up with our host Raphael Mushumba of Community Action for Mercy. The trip was centred around Kigali and the team were involved in such diverse activities as visiting a pre-school education centre,

college education centre, co-operative savings and investment scheme, and culminating in an evangelistic open-air outreach event. Nearly 300 people were saved during this trip.
